**ADJECTIVE ORDER**

When more than one adjective is used to describe something, all the adjectives need to be placed in the correct order.

**THIS IS THE CORRECT ORDER FOR ADJECTIVE PLACEMENT.**

- NUMBER** (five, seven)
- OPINION** (lovely, useless)
- SIZE** (big, tiny)
- AGE** (mature, ancient)
- SHAPE** (square, oval)
- COLOR** (red, burgundy)
- ORIGIN** (American, English)
- MATERIAL** (wooden, cotton)
- PURPOSE** (fishing, sun)

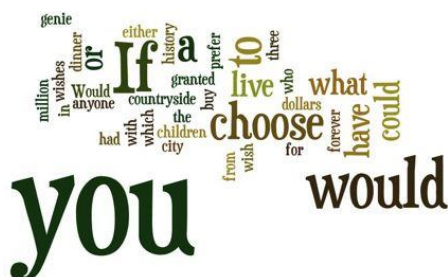

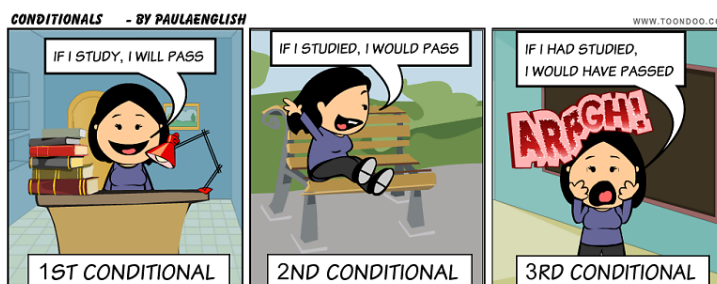
